ORDER

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner/accused No.3 and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been complying with conditions imposed by this Court in CrI.P.No.13185 of 2025, dated 08.01.2026, without fail and prays for relaxation of the conditions.

The learned Assistant Public Prosecutor opposed the petition and prays that appropriate orders may be passed.

For the reasons mentioned in the petition and submissions made, the condition imposed by the learned Single Judge in CrI.P.No.13181 of 2025, dated 08.01.2026 in paragraph No.5(ii) that the petitioner/accused No.3 shall appear before the Station House Officer concerned on every Saturday between 10.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m., till filing of the charge sheet is modified and the petitioner is directed to appear before the Station House Officer concerned on every Sunday between 10.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m., till filing of the charge sheet.

Accordingly, I.A.No.1 of 2026 is allowed.
