Petition under Sections 484, 483(1), 483(1)(b) of BNSS, 2023 (528 BNSS) is filed praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed in support of the petition, the High Court may be pleased to modify the order dt. 17.02.2026 passed by this Honble High Court of Andhra Pradesh in I.A.No. 1 of 2026 in CRLP.No.13181 of 2025 by considering the situation of the Petitioner/Accused No. 3 as "Petitioner/Accused No. 3 shall appear before the Station House Officer concerned once in a month on Sunday at 10:00 am, till filing of the charge sheet" instead of "The Petitioner/Accused No.3 shall appear before the Station House Officer concerned, on every Sunday in between 10:00 am and 05:00 pm, till filing of the charge sheet, Pending disposal of CRLP No. 13181 of 2025, on the file of the High Court.

The court while directing issue of notice to the Respondents herein to show cause as to why this application should not be complied with, made the following order.(The receipt of this order will be deemed to be the receipt of notice in the case).

**ORDER**

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner/accused No.3 and learned Assistant Public Prosecutor.

The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the order dated 17.03.2026 passed by this Court in I.A. No. 1 of 2026 in CrI.P. No. 13181 of 2025, directing the petitioner to appear before the Station House Officer concerned on every Sunday between 10.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m. till filing of the charge sheet (instead of Saturday), prays for relaxation of the said condition.

The learned Assistant Public Prosecutor opposes the petition and prays that appropriate orders may be passed.

For the reasons stated in the petition and in view of the submissions made, the order dated 17.03.2026 passed in I.A. No. 1 of 2026 is modified, and the petitioner is directed to appear before the Station House Officer concerned once in a month, i.e., on every last Sunday between 10.00 a.m. and 5.00 p.m., till filing of the charge sheet."

Accordingly, I.A.No.2 of 2026 is ordered.
