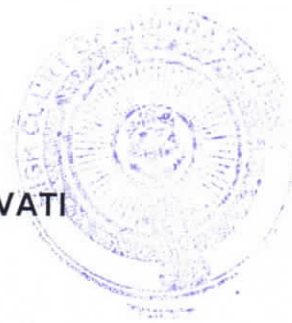

WHEREAS the Petitioners/Accused above named through their Advocate VARUN BYREDDY presented this Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to set aside the condition imposed by way of order dated 13.12.2022 in CrI.M.P No. 967 2022 in CC No. 671 of 2017 on the file of the Court of Judicial Magistrate of First Class, Kurnool directing the Petitioners herein to deposit 20% of the cheque amount as illegal and contrary to the provisions of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 and the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 ,

AND WHEREAS the High Court upon perusing the petition and memorandum of grounds filed herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri VARUN BYREDDY Advocate for the Petitioners, PUBLIC PROSECUTOR for the Respondent No.1, directed issue of notice to the Respondent No.2, herein to show cause as to why this CRIMINAL PETITION should not be admitted.
