affidavit filed in support thereof and the High Court orders dated 07.01.2026,

12.03.2026 & 30.03.2026 made herein and upon hearing the arguments of Sri B V KRISHNA REDDY, Advocate for the Petitioner, Sri Chalasani Venkaiah, Advocate for the Respondent, the Court made the following

ORDER:

Sri Y.Sitharam, learned counsel for the respondent, submits that the respondent is also willing for the resolution of the dispute amicably through the process of mediation.

2. Accordingly, the parties shall appear before the mediation and conciliation centre of this Court on 06.05.2026, which would be the first date. The subsequent dates for sessions shall be fixed by the mediation centre. The mediation centre through its mediators shall make endeavour to complete the proceedings within a period of three months from the date of first appearance of the parties, and submit the report to this Court.

3. Let the copy of this order be sent to the mediation centre of this Court with the particulars of this case.

4. Since the parties are being referred to the mediation, considering the submissions advanced as also the consequences vide from the divorce decree, we stay operation of the decree of divorce and the parties shall not remarry, till the next date of listing.

5. Post after the receipt of the report from the mediation centre.

6. Interim order granted earlier in CMA No.889 of 2025 is extended till the next date of listing.
