WHEREAS the Petitioner above named through its Advocate Sri V S R Anjaneyalu presented this Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a Writ, order or direction particularly one in the nature of writ of Mandamus declaring the proceedings in Rc.No. 3/A/2008-13, dated 22.11.2013 and 09.12.2013 issued by the respondent No. 2 as illegal and ultra vires to the provisions of Articles 14 and 19(1)(g) of the Constitution of India besides being in violation of the provisions of the A.P. (Agricultural Produce and Livestock) Markets Act, 1966 and Rules framed thereunder besides directing not to proceed further;
