ORDER:-

The petitioners have attained the age of superannuation during pendency of the writ petition. The learned Assistant Government Pleader submitted that case of the petitioners for absorption into grant-in-aid post could not be considered on account of the then prevailing ban. It is further submitted that the petitioners could not be accommodated in the 3rd respondent college on account of lack of vacancies.

2. Be that as it may, considering the submission that the petitioners have attained the age of superannuation, no further orders can be passed.

3. Accordingly, the Writ Petition is closed. There shall be no order as to costs.

Pending miscellaneous petitions, if any, shall stand closed.
