2	29.04.2026	<u>GTK,J</u> <u>I.A.No.1 of 2016.</u> Counsel for the appellant/Insurance Company argued that there is delay of 100 days in filing the appeal and the reasons for the delay are appended to the original application. After going through the reasons so mentioned, this Court is of the opinion that the reasons are satisfactorily explained and the Counsel for the Claimant(s) has also seriously not objected for condoning the same. Hence, the application for condonation of delay is allowed. <u>M.A.C.M.A (S.R).No. 17871 of 2016</u> As seen from the docket order, dated 16.06.2016 the appellant was directed to deposit 50% of the decretal	

amount along with the proportionate costs and interest within a period of six (06) weeks and since then, the matter is not listed.

Today, on behalf of claimant Sri M.Venkatramana Reddy marked his appearance and stated that as there is no direction to withdraw the amount, the amount could not be withdrawn and requested the Court to pass orders so as to enable to withdraw the amount so deposited.

Therefore, there shall be a direction to the claimants to withdraw the amount deposited by the appellant as per the docket order dated 16.06.2016.

Post the matter after two (02) weeks.
