Heard the parties.

2. The present restoration petition has been filed for restoration of F.A. No. 258 of 1994 to its original file, which was dismissed for non-compliance of the peremptory order dated 13.07.2018, by which four weeks' time was granted to the learned counsel for the appellant to comply the order dated 10.05.2017 passed by the Lawazima Board, whereby defects were directed to be removed.

3. The learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent/opposite party does not object to the prayers made in





the restoration petition.

4. In view of the statements made in the present restoration petition, including paragraph nos. 4 and 9, the restoration petition is allowed.
