This Writ application has been filed for the following

reliefs:-

- (i) *The petitioners be protected from being disposed of the ancestral plot under their cultivation. They are apprehensive of being disposed of by the private respondent.*
- (ii) *The official Respondents be directed to take into consideration the grievance of the dispossession of the petitioners from their ancestral property which was acquired by their grandfather and*





are in peaceful possession of the same without any dispute.

- (iii) *The necessary direction be issued to the respondent D.C.L.R. Bagha-II to decide the dispute between petitioner's family and private respondents with respect to plot no. 143 belong to the petitioners at once.*

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are the owner of Plot Nos. 141 and 142 appertaining to Khata No. 22, Thana No.141, situated in Village-Ausani, District West Champaran, which is the ancestral property. It is further submitted that the private respondents are trying to disturb the peaceful possession of the petitioners over the land in question. However, Plot No. 143 of Khata No. 22 is disputed plot. The private respondents are trying to disturb the petitioners' possession and the respondents also claim of occupancy right over the suit land. It is further submitted that the dispute with regard to Plot No. 143 is pending before D.C.L.R. There is no dispute with regard to Plot Nos. 141 & 142. These plots are situated very closed to Plot No. 143. It is further submitted that the petitioners filed petition before Circle Officer, Bagaha-2 as well as Officer-in-Charge and a detailed representation was also filed before the District Magistrate, Bettiah, West Champaran on 02.02.2026, but no action has been taken so far.





3. Having regard to the nature of the grievance of the petitioners, the District Magistrate, Bettiah, West Champaran (respondent no. 1) is directed to dispose of the representation of the petitioners filed on 02.02.2026 (Annexure-P/1) within one month from the date of production of a copy of this order.

4. Accordingly, this writ application is disposed of with the aforesaid direction.
