learned counsel for the State.

2. The present writ application has been filed with the
following reliefs:-

*(i) To direct the respondents authorities
to absorb the services of the petitioners on regular
basis in Durgawati Project which is based at
district of kaimur and Rohtas.*

*(ii) To consider the case of the
petitioners on the basis of the Government
Circulars Commitment of the Government of
Published in the newspaper dated 26.01.2005.*

*(iii) To hold and declare that the right
which accrue after continuous employment of 240
days in indefeasible.*

3. Counsel for the State raised preliminary objection
and submits that the petitioners were daily wager and need their
regularization in the particular project of the State of Bihar.

4. It transpires to this Court that the relief which has
been demanded by the petitioner, ought to be demanded before





the authorities of Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, now called as Industrial Relations Code, 2020.

5. In this view of the matter, this Court without entering into merit and demerit of this case, disposed off the present writ application granting liberty to the petitioners to avail their remedy before the Industrial Relations Code, 2020 within 60 days from today.

6. Limitations, if any, is hereby directed to be condoned.

7. Accordingly, the present writ application stands disposed off.
