4 02-12-2025 Following are the reliefs sought for in the present writ application :-

"(A) For a direction to the





respondent authorities to lodge the F.I.R. against the P.R No. 9 in view of the enquiry report dated 03.01.2025 in which it has been found that P.R.No. 9 has defalcated the public money violating the rule in distributing the money.

(B) For direction to the respondent authorities to remove to the PR.No. 9 from the post of Pramukh of Rafiganj Block and seized the financial power of her in view of the section 44(4) & 44(5) of Panchayati Raj Act 2006 on the basis of enquiry report dated 04.01.2025 vide letter No. 35 issued by Additional Collector Cum District Public Complaint Resolution Officer, Aurangabad.

(C) For any other order/orders on the basis of facts and circumstances stated herein-after of the case."

2. From the reliefs sought on behalf of the petitioners, it appears that they are seeking a direction for institution of an FIR and removal of the Pramukh of Rafiganj Block alongwith seizure of her financial powers.

3. In our considered opinion, such reliefs are not maintainable in a Public Interest Litigation.

4. Considering the materials available on record and the reliefs prayed for, we are not inclined to entertain the present





writ petition.

5. Accordingly, this writ application stands dismissed.
