2 15-04-2026 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
counsel for the respondents.

2. The petitioner has filed the instant application for
the following reliefs:

*“1. (A) For issuance of an
appropriate writ in the nature of
Ceriorari for quashing and set aside
the order contained in Memo
No.391/Ist dated 11.03.2025 passed by
the learned Collector, Saran Chapra*





(respondent no.2) whereunder and whereby the petitioner was imposed punishment to stop three instalment of his salary with commulative effect.

(B) Any other relief or reliefs to which the petitioner may be deemed entitled to be in the eye of law.”

3. At the outset, it is submitted by learned counsel for the respondents that the petitioner has an alternate and efficacious remedy of filing an appeal against the order impugned before the Commissioner, Saran Division, Chapra.

4. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and having perused the contents of the petition, the writ application is disposed of directing the petitioner to file an appeal/revision before the Commissioner, Saran Division, Chapra (not a party herein) within a period of four weeks.

5. On filing of the appeal/revision, the Commissioner, Saran Division, Chapra shall decide the same in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of its filing.

6. On filing of the appeal/revision, the question of limitation shall be considered taking into consideration the petitioner pursuing his remedy before this Court.





7. The writ application stands disposed of with the
above observations and directions.
