Heard learned counsel for the parties.

2. The petitioners have filed the instant application for

the following relief (s) :-

“1. That, this is an application for issuance of the appropriate writ/writs, order/orders or direction/directions to the respondent authorities to allot the Share and issued the Licence of a Shop situated under Gola Bazar, Sasaram, Plot. No.223, Ward No.03.(Old), Ward No.26(New), 47 Kari in





the favour of the petitioners as per their Share allotted in the entire Lease Area (47 Kari) and also for restraining the respondents No.5 and 6 to not disturb the possession of the petitioner.”

3. Having heard learned counsel for the parties, the writ application is disposed of giving liberty to the petitioners to file a representation before the Municipal Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Sasaram, Rohtas (respondent no.3) within a period of four weeks from today. Any representation so filed shall be disposed of by the respondent no.3 in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of its filing.

4. It is made clear that the Court has not entered into the merits of the case of the petitioners which is to be decided by the respondent concerned.

5. The writ application stands disposed of.
