ORAL ORDER

2 28-04-2026 The petitioner has filed the instant application for
the following relief (s) :-

“1. (I) For issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of MANDAMUS, commanding and directing the Respondent Authorities not to allow those voters to of cast their vote in the forthcoming election Halimpur Primary Agriculture Credit Cooperative Societies (hereinafter referred to as the Society) scheduled to be held on 20.04.2026, who were unmarried at the time when they were granted membership of the society in question but after the marriage they are settled in their matrimonial house since much before yet their name has not been deleted from the voter list deliberately.

(II) For issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of MANDAMUS, commanding and directing the Respondent Authorities not to allow those voters to cast their vote in the election of the Respondent Society scheduled to be held on





20.04.2026, who admittedly does not belong to the territorial area of the Society in question even according to their address as mentioned in the voter list itself.

(III) For issuance of any other appropriate writ/writs, order/ orders, direction/directions for which the writ petitioner would be found entitled under the facts and circumstances of the case.”

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the elections having been conducted, the prayer made in the instant application has become infructuous and as such he does not press the same. Learned counsel further submits that he will be raising the points raised herein in the election petition.

3. In view of the above, the application is disposed of as not pressed.
