counsel with Mr. Sangiv Kumar, Advocate for the petitioner and
learned counsel for the Union of India.

2. The present writ application has been filed with the
following reliefs:-

*1. That, this is an application for
issuance of appropriate writ, order or direction to
the respondents to allow joining of the petitioner
after allocating battalion of BSF and to grant
disability pension as he was declared category C
and for grant of all consequential benefits.*

3. It transpires to this Court that the present writ
petition has been poorly drafted, neither appointment date nor





retirements date of the petitioner have been given.

4. Counsel for the Union of India submits that from the SOF which he has received, it has come that the petitioner was enrolled in BSF as Constable (GD) on 10.11.2002. During absence without leave period, the petitioner forwarded an application dated 16.05.2008. He further submits that the petitioner was dismissed from his service *w.e.f.*, 08.04.2009.

5. In this view of the matter, the present writ petition is hereby dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to draft properly and take course in accordance with law.
