2. The present writ petition has been filed with the
following reliefs:-

*I. For issuance of the appropriate writ,
order(s) or directions(s) in the nature of
'Mandamus' for commanding/directing the
respondent authorities, especially the respondent
no.-2, District Magistrate, Nalanda to forthwith
undertake a thorough, impartial and transparent
enquiry regarding the appointment of Anita
Kumari (Respondent No. 5) to the post of
Anganwadi Sevika at Ward No.- 09, Anganwadi
Centre No.- 81, Block Hilsa, Akbarpur Panchayat,*





District-Nalanda.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has filed a representation before the Collector for illegal Aam Sabha, which has been conducted. Therefore, a direction may be made to the respondents for conduction of selection process afresh.

4. Learned counsel for the State and respondents both submit that the selection process has already been made in accordance with law and the selected persons are functioning and any challenge of the selection can be made only according to the established process of law.

5. In this view of the matter, this Court finds that the selection has been made and therefore, this case becomes infructuous, but liberty is hereby granted to the petitioner that if she wants to challenge the appointment of selected person, then she may avail her remedy according to applicable Margdarshika Rule for appointment of Anganwari Sevika or Sahayika.

6. With the aforesaid direction, the present writ application is hereby disposed off.
