2. The present petition has been preferred for the
following relief(s):

*“(i) For issuance of a direction to the
respondent authority for disbursement of the land
acquired appertaining to 5 decimal, by Notification
No.2725 dated 05.11.2024 without any notice to
the petitioner, without giving opportunity for
hearing to the petitioner, therefore, the entire land*





*bearing Khata No.100, tauji no.227 plot no.1451
area 1 acre 5 decimal.*

*(ii) For issuance of a direction to the
Additional Collector (Land Acquisition), Patna
(Respondent No.4) whereas the petitioner has filed
a representation with regard to grant of
compensation to the petitioner which has been
acquired as per notification issued by the
Government of Bihar, dated 05.11.2024 vide
Notification No.2725 (Annexure-P/1).*

*(iii) For any other relief/reliefs to which
the petitioner may be found entitled to, be granted
to the petitioner.”*

3. After some argument, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he be permitted to appear before the respondent no. 3, the District Land Acquisition Officer, Patna for the redressal of the grievance.

4. Learned State counsel has no objection to it.

5. In that background, the writ petition stands disposed of allowing the petitioners to approach the respondent no. 3, the District Land Acquisition Officer, Patna within a period of four weeks who shall be duty bound to look into the





matter and pass an appropriate order, in accordance with law, at
an earliest.
