ORAL ORDER

3 07-09-2026 Heard Mr. Sunil Kumar Yadav, learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

2. The present petition has been preferred for the following relief(s):

“a) To Quash/ Set aside the order dated 15.04.2026 passed by ADM, Gaya passed in Jamabandi Cancellation Case (JBCA) No. 224/2022-23 whereby and where under cancelled the Jamabandi no. 251/2011 issued on settlement Case No.347/1987-88 on erroneous ground.

b) To direct the respondents to not disturb the petitioner who resides upon the land in question for ninety five years, having got it by the then





Jamindar who issued Hukumnama in favour of ancestor of petitioner since 04.02.1931.

c) To issue status quo upon the land till final decision of the case.

d) Any other relief(s) for which petitioner is entitled for the ends of Justice.”

3. Learned State counsel has pointed out that an appeal has already been preferred against the order in question before the Collector, Gaya Ji vide Jamabandi Cancellation Appeal No. 31 of 2026-27 which will be taken to its logical conclusion at an earliest.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that protection be granted in the matter as long standing *jamabandi* has been cancelled.

5. This Court in the aforesaid background, disposes of the writ petition with a direction to the Collector, Gaya Ji to take the aforesaid appeal (Jamabandi Cancellation Appeal No. 31 of 2026-27) to its logical conclusion at an earliest. Till then, the status quo, as existing today, shall be maintained.
