From perusal of record it appears that the present memo of Appeal has been filed u/s 299 of the Indian Succession Act, 1925 against judgment dated 29.01.2025 passed by learned fast District and Additional Judge-II, Saran at Chapra in probate case no. 61 of 2018, whereby learned court below has rejected the case.
