ORAL ORDER

2 07-09-2026 Heard Mr. Vishwajeet Kumar Mishra, learned counsel for the petitioner and learned State counsel.

2. The present petition has been preferred for the grant of following relief(s):

“(i) for issuance of appropriate writ, order(s) or direction(s) upon Respondent no.2 to restrain the respondent no.5, 6 and 7 from encroaching upon the petitioner's land and remove all encroachment upon petitioner's property upon correct demarcation upon it.

(ii) for any other relief(s) in favour of





*the Petitioner as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit
and proper in the interest of justice, equity and
good conscience.”*

3. After some argument, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it will suffice if his petitioner before the Collector, Vaishali at Hajipur is taken up and disposed of in accordance with law.

4. Learned State counsel submits that the said petition is bereft of supporting documents.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a fresh petition shall be filed alongwith all the supporting documents in next four weeks.

6. If such petition is preferred in next four weeks alongwith supporting documents, the Collector, Vaishali at Hajipur shall be taking up the matter and after noticing/hearing all the parties, it is expected that the same will be taken to its logical conclusion, at an earliest.

7. The writ petition is disposed of with the aforesaid observation.
