2. The present petition has been preferred for the following relief(s):

“for initiation of contempt proceeding against the contemnors/opposite parties for their willful disobedience of the order dated 16.02.2017 passed in CWJC No. 12141 of 2015.”

3. In this case, the Writ Court on 16.02.2017 in CWJC No. 12141 of 2015 recorded that disputed question of fact cannot be decided by the Court and the petitioner is well advised to take legal recourse as available in the law.
