2. The present petition has been preferred for the grant of following relief(s):

“(i) for direction to the respondent concerned to pay compensation to the petitioner on the basis of rate fixed for commercial house of the house and land of the petitioner which has been acquired for the purpose of Babura Doriganj Ganga Pool cum approach road along with interest at the rate of current market rate.





(ii) for any other relief/reliefs for which the petitioner is found entitled in the facts and circumstances of the case.”

3. After some argument, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he shall be approaching the appellate authority within next four weeks.

4. Learned State counsel has no objection.

5. In that background, the writ petition is disposed of allowing the petitioner to approach the concerned authority and while taking up the petition, the authority shall take into account that the matter was pending before this Court so far as the delay part is concerned.
