issued quashing the order dated-19.09.2023*





passed by the Divisional Commissioner, Tirhut Division, Muzaffarpur, the Respondent No.2 in Sairat Appeal Case No.272 of 2023 as contained in Annexure-P/11 whereby an where under the Respondent No.2 the Divisional Commissioner has cancelled the settlement of total 67 fish jalkars settled with the petitioner society by an order dated-08.07.2023, issued by the District Fisheries Officer, East Champaran, Motihari, the Respondent No-6 vide Letter / Memo No.701 dated-08.07.2023 as contained in Annexure-P/8 and also directed to settle the total 67 jalkars afresh through limited / open bid under section-7 (ix) of the Bihar Fish Jalkar Management Act, 2006 as amended time to time.

II. That an appropriate writ may be issued commanding upon the Respondent No-6 the District Fisheries Officer, East Champaran, Motihari not to conduct any limited / open bid in compliance of the order dated-19.09.2023 passed by the Divisional Commissioner, Tirhut Division, Muzaffarpur, the Respondent No.2 in Sairat Appeal Case No.272 of 2023 as contained in Annexure-P/11 during the pendency of this writ application.

III. That any other relief/reliefs for which the petitioners are found entitled to.





3. Learned counsel for the petitioner, Mr. Ram Nibash Prasad, prays for withdrawal of the petition.

4. Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

5. Interim protection, if any, stands vacated.
