2. The present writ petition has been filed for the following reliefs:-

“(i) For issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents to consider the case of the petitioner for payment of equal salary in the correct and revised Grade pay which is being paid to the other government employees holding the same post on account of the principle





of equal pay for equal work.

(ii) For issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents to pay the arrears of salary to the petitioner accrued on account his pay fixation in the correct and enhanced grade pay from the date of his appointment.

(iii) For grant of any other incidental or consequential relief to which the petitioner may be found entitled to considering the facts and circumstances of the present case.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the reliefs sought for in the present writ petition is no longer *res integra* in view of paragraph no. 55 of the judgment of the Full Bench of this Court reported in **2025 (4) PLJR 162 (Ravi Shankar Kumar vs. State of Bihar)**.

4. Accordingly, the present writ petition is dismissed in terms of the judgment of the Full Bench of this Court in **Ravi Shankar Kumar vs. State of Bihar** (supra),
