petitioner alleging non-compliance of the order dated

19.09.2018 passed by a co-ordinate bench of this Court in

CWJC No. 4919 of 2018.

2. A supplementary show cause has been filed on
behalf of opposite party No. 3, wherein following statements
have been made in paragraph No. 7 :

*"7. That accordingly, the Circle
Officer, Patliputra has passed order dated
08.04.2026 under section-6(1) of the Bihar
Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956, whereby
the constructions made over the land in
question between Digha Gate No.-79 to 83,*





besides Shahar Suraksha Bandh has been declared as encroachments over the Government land under Plot no.-5131, Mauza-Digha, Thana no.-01. Further, direction has been given to issue notice under section-6(2) of the Bihar Public Land Encroachment Act, 1956 for removing encroachments otherwise it shall be removed by the Administration."

3. Considering the statements made in paragraph 7 of the supplementary show cause, it appears that the order passed by the writ court has now been complied with.

4. In view of the aforesaid, this Court is of the view that no further order is required to be passed in the present matter.

5. Accordingly, the present application stands disposed of.

6. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
