Ms. Laxmeen Kashyap, Advocate on behalf of Mr. Vikrant Pillay, Advocate for respondents No.2 & 3. Heard. By the present writ petition, the petitioners are questioning the order dated 27/12/2024 passed by the appellate tribunal constituted under the Maintenance and Welfare of Parents and Senior Citizens Act, 2007. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submit that pursuance to the said order passed by the Tribunal, the revenue authority proceeded to execute the order dated 12/09/2024 passed by the SDO (Revenue), Bilaspur and it is highly expected that the



	petitioners may be evicted from the house in question which has been given to the petitioners by a registered gift deed executed in 2016. He further submits that the petitioners are ready to live with the respondents in the house in question but they themselves have left the house. Ms. Laxmeen Kashyap, Advocate appears on behalf of Mr. Vikrant Pillay, learned counsel for respondents No.2 & 3 on caveat submits that the arguing counsel is not available today to argue the matter. Looking to the urgency and apprehension of eviction pursuance to the order dated 12/09/2024 passed by the SDO as well as the order dated 27/12/2024 passed by the appellate tribunal, the order dated 12/09/2024 passed by the SDO shall remain stayed till the next date of hearing. Learned counsel for the petitioners as well as for the respondents submit that the present matter be referred to Mediation and Conciliation Center of this Court being a family dispute as there are chances to compromise between the parties amicably. Considering the fact that the dispute arrived at between the parties is a family dispute, this Court seems it appropriate to make an effort to get the said
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dispute settled by way of mediation.

In view of above, the matter is referred to the Mediation Centre for appearance of the parties on Thursday i.e. 09/01/2025 with a direction that the parties shall appear on the said date before the Mediation Centre of this Court and the Mediation Centre shall conclude the mediation proceedings expeditiously.

List this case for further hearing along with the report of Mediation Centre after a week.
