25/04/2026	Heard Ms. Sangeeta Mishra, learned counsel for the appellant appearing through legal aid, as well as Mr. Shailendra Sharma, learned Panel Lawyer, appearing for the State/ respondent. IA No. 02 of 2026 is an application for condonation of delay of 22 days in preferring the appeal. Since the learned State counsel has no objection if delay in filing the appeal is condoned as the accused has statutory right to file an appeal and cause shown by the appellant in filing the appeal beyond the time appears to be satisfactory, we condone the delay in filing the present appeal. Admit.
