No. 01, application for suspension of sentence and grant of bail. The applicant has been convicted for the offence punishable under Section 338 of IPC and sentenced to undergo RI for one year with fine of Rs.1,000 with default stipulation vide order dated 16.11.2016 passed by the 1st Additional Sessions Judge, Raipur in Criminal Appeal No. 231/2015 affirming the order dated 02.11.2015 passed by the JMFC, Raipur in Criminal case No. 473/2010. Taking into consideration the short sentence imposed upon the applicant and the fact that the present revision is of the year 2016, this Court is of the opinion that it is a fit case where the applicant can be released on bail. Accordingly, I.A. No.01 for suspension of sentence and grant of bail is allowed.	

It is directed that the jail sentence imposed upon the applicant shall remain suspended during the pendency of this revision and he shall be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of Rs. 25,000/- with one surety in like sum to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court. The applicant is directed to appear before the trial Court on each and every date given to him by the said Court till disposal of the revision.

Let this matter be listed for final hearing in due course.
