WPC NO. 208 OF 2020**Jagdish Kumar Pandey VS. State of Chhattisgarh & Others**

08/02/2022	Mr. Barun Kumar Chakrabarty, Advocate, for Petitioner. Mr. P. Acharya, Panel Lawyer, for Respondents. Matter is today taken up for consideration on I.As. No.1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8 & 9. These are all applications which are filed by the Petitioner for bringing documents on record and for granting ad-interim relief. Learned Counsel for Petitioner submits that the Petitioner has an Interim Order his favour passed by this Court on 20.9.2021 and the said Interim Order was in respect of the land in possession of the Petitioner, i.e., the land which situates at Khasra No.98 in Village Sambhalpur, District Gariyaband. Learned Counsel for Petitioner further submits that subsequently now the Respondents seem to have renumbered the Khasras in that area and the land, which is in possession of the Petitioner, in the course of renumbering has been marked as Khasra No.47 and since the Interim Order granted by this Court was for Khasra No.98, the Respondents have now initiated steps for dispossessing the Petitioner from the said land and also for demolishing the house that was constructed by the Petitioner in that land. Though it is more than two years have passed since the present Writ Petition has been filed, the Respondents have not yet filed their Reply. Learned Panel Lawyer prays for and is granted a short adjournment to file their Reply. Meanwhile, the interim order earlier passed by this Court on



20.9.2021 is further extended. It is also clarified that the Petitioner would have the interim protection of not being forcefully dispossessed/evicted. The demolition work initiated by the Respondents on the property which is in possession of the Petitioner since long, merely because the Khasra number has got renumbered or it has got wrongly written, would not allow the Respondents to initiate coercive steps against the Petitioner's peaceful possession of the said property.

Let this matter now be listed for further hearing in the week commencing 25.4.2022.

All the I.As., accordingly stand disposed of.
