ORDER ON BOARD

1. This is the second bail application filed by the applicant under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of regular bail, as he has been arrested in connection with Crime No. 04/2024 registered at Police Station – Pakhanjur, District – Kanker, Chhattisgarh for the offences punishable under Sections 302/34, 201, 120 (B) of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and under Sections 25 (1-b) (a) & 27 (3) of the Arms Act, 1959.
2. Perusal of the order passed by the learned Trial Court 05.06.2025 (Annexure A/2) would show that it is passed by Special Judge (N.I.A.), District – North-Baster Kanker (C.G.). Under the provision of Section 21 (a) of the N.I.A. Act, 2008, the order passed in bail application is appealable and therefore, the



application for grant of bail filed under Section 483 of the B.N.S.S., 2023 is not maintainable. Accordingly, it is **dismissed**.

3. At this stage, learned counsel for the applicant submits that directions may be issued to return back certified copy of the documents enclosed along with the bail application after filing appropriate proceedings.
4. In view of the above, Registry is directed to return back the certified copies of the documents enclosed along with the bail application after retaining photocopies of the same.
