Mr. Aditya Sanghi, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, would submit that the petitioner, through the present writ petition, seeks relief pertaining to Labour Laws and the Voluntary Retirement Scheme (VRS). He would pray that in light of the nature of

the relief sought, this matter may be converted into a Writ Petition (Labour) [WPL].

On the other hand, learned counsel appearing for the respondents would oppose.

Taking into consideration the submission made by Mr. Sanghi, the application (I.A. No.2/2024) is **allowed**. The petitioner is permitted to carry out necessary corrections within a period of 7 working days.
