1. Heard.

2. The petitioner has filed this contempt petition against alleged disobedience of order dated 16.06.2025 passed in WPS No.4564 of 2025, wherein, following observation was made :

“Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and the principles of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the petition is allowed. The respondent authorities are directed to inspect the records of others similarly situated employees when their services were regularized. If the case



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of the petitioners are also found to be similar to those daily wagers/contract basis whose services were regularized, their services be also regularized from the same date. It is also directed that all this exercise be completed within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of copy of this order.”

3. Mr. Shrivastava, Advocate appearing for respondent No.3 would submit that the claim of the petitioner with regard to regularization has already been rejected by respondent No.3 vide order dated 06.03.2026.
4. At this stage, Mr. Yadav, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would seek permission of this Court to withdraw this contempt petition with liberty to challenge the order dated 06.03.2026.
5. No objection from other side.
6. Permission is granted.
7. With the liberty as prayed for, this contempt petition is **dismissed** as withdrawn.
