Issue notice to the respondents by both mode. Learned counsel for the State accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 6, hence, issuance of notice to them is dispensed with. PF be paid within a week only for respondents No.7 to 9. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a recorded owner of his ancestral property bearing Khasra No.379, 379/3, 383 area 0.4050 hectare and 1.1330 hectare respectively situated at village Devda, Tahsil Bhanpuri, Distt. Bastar. He further submits that without any permission of the petitioner and without initiating any legal proceedings, road is being constructed on the aforesaid land and on being enquired by him, it was not informed to the petitioner that which authority/department is constructing the road. Learned counsel further submits that earlier also in the aforesaid land, tin shed was being constructed for the vegetable venders, which the petitioner had got stopped by the authorities. Therefore, interim protection may be granted to the petitioner. Having considered the prayer of the petitioner, it is directed that status-quo, as it exists today, in respect of land of the petitioner bearing Khasra No.379, 379/3, 383 area 0.4050 hectare and 1.1330 hectare respectively, situated at village Devda, Tahsil Bhanpuri, Distt. Bastar, shall be maintained by the
