- 1 Heard Mr. Ratnesh Kumar Agrawal and Mr. Sourav Agrawal, learned counsel for the petitioners as well as Mr. S.S. Baghel, learned Government Advocate, appearing for the State/ respondents.
- 2 The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023 seeking following prayers :

"1. That, this Hon'ble Court may kindly be please to allow the petition and quash the First Information Report no. 27/2022, dated 20.01.2022 registered by respondent no. 2 (Annexure-P/1).

2. That, this Hon'ble Court may kindly be please to quash the charge sheet no. 688/2022 dated 11.10.2022 (Annexure-P/2).

3. That, this Hon'ble Court may kindly be please to quash the order dated 02.12.2022 passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class Lormi, District



Mungeli (C.G.) (Annexure-P/3) and further be please to quash the proceedings of the Criminal Case No. 1528/2022 between "State of Chhattisgarh Vs. Anil Patel & others" pending before the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class Lormi, District Mungeli (C.G.), is in the interest of justice."

- 3 Learned counsel for the petitioners vehemently argued that the proceedings pending before the Court of Judicial Magistrate First Class, Lormi, District – Mungeli in Criminal Case No. 1528 of 2022 against the main accused Anil Patel has already been quashed by this Court in CRMP No. 485 of 2022 on the basis of compromise entered between him and private respondent Nos.2 to 8 in the said petition, hence, the proceedings against the present petitioners be also quashed and it is stated that till date charges have not been framed at it is reflected from the order-sheet of the trial Court.
- 4 But, considering the fact that the proceedings against co-accused Anil Patel has been quashed by this Court on the basis of compromise entered between the parties and so far as the present petitioners are concerned, it is reflected from the order-sheet of the trial Court that the charges could not be framed as the petitioners have been moving exemption applications for their presence and lingering on the trial, we are not inclined to interfere.
- 5 Accordingly, the present petition is **dismissed**.
