29/01/2026	Heard Mr.Sandeep Jha, learned counsel for the petitioners as well as Mr.Priyank Rathi, learned Government Advocate appearing for respondent No.1/State. Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that there is a matrimonial dispute between petitioner No. 5 and respondent No. 2 and marriage between them was solemnized on 11.02.2021 in Arya Samaj, Baijnathpara, Raipur (CG) and the present FIR has been lodged by respondent No. 2 against the petitioners for harassment on 24.07.2023. He further submits that the present matter be referred to Mediation Centre of this Court

being matrimonial in nature as there may be chances of compromise between the parties.

Considering the fact that the dispute arrived at between the parties i.e. petitioner No. 5 and respondent No. 2 is matrimonial in nature, we deem it appropriate to make an effort to get the said dispute settled by way of mediation.

In view of above, petitioner No. 5 shall deposit Rs. 50,000/- with the Mediation Centre of this Court and the same shall be paid to respondent No. 2 on her appearance before the Mediation Centre.

The matter is remitted to the Mediation Centre of this Court. Parties are directed to appear before the Mediation Centre of this Court on 10.02.2026.

List this matter on 24.02.2026 along with Mediation Centre report.

Till the next date of listing, further proceedings pending before the Judicial Magistrate First Class, Durg in RCC No.2231/2024 arising out of the FIR

Bablu	No.0075/2023 registered at Police Station Mahila Thana Sector 06, Bhilai (Durg) for offence under Sections 498A, 323 and 34 of the IPC shall remain stayed. It is also made clear that if any final settlement is arrived at between the parties, the aforesaid amount so deposited, shall be adjusted.
