WP (Art.227) No.48 of 2022Ku. Chetishtha Malik **Versus** Smt. Neelam Malik

18/2/2022	Mr. V.A. Goverdhan, Advocate for the petitioner. Mr. G.P. Kurre, Panel Lawyer for the State. Heard. As per office note dated 18.2.2022, notice issued to respondent No.1 is served, but as per service report dated 11.2.2022 available in file shows that notice issued to respondent No.1 was returned un-served with note "respondent No.1 is not residing at the given address and she resides in Haryana". Learned counsel for petitioner would submit that in cause title of petition two different address of respondent No.1 are given, one of Gurgaon (Haryana) and another of District Bemetara (Chhattisgarh). It is mentioned in cause title that presently respondent No.1 is residing in District Bemetara, State of Chhattisgarh. He submits that in view of noting dated 11.2.2022 of the Process Server in service report, he may be permitted to pay fresh process fee for issuance of notice to respondent No.1 on both the



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addresses given in cause title of writ petition.

In above circumstances, particularly in view of noting of Process Server dated 11.2.2022, petitioner is permitted to pay fresh process fee for issuance of notice to respondent No.1 on both addresses mentioned in cause title of writ petition.

On petitioners' paying fresh process fee within three days, issue notice to respondent No.1 on both the addresses given in cause title of petition, making it returnable in three weeks.
