1. The petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking for the following relief(s);

“10.1 That, this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to issue appropriate directions to the learned Second Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Raipur, District - Raipur (C.G.), to expeditiously dispose of Case No. 942/2022 within a time-bound period, preferably within three months from the date of order, by completing the respondent's evidence and proceeding to final arguments and judgment.

10.2 That, this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to direct the Family Court to avoid unnecessary adjournments and ensure day-to-day hearing if necessary, to prevent further delay.

10.3 That, this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to grant any other relief/reliefs in favour of the petitioner, which the Hon'ble Court deemed fit & just in the facts and circumstances of the case.”



2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present writ petition seeks a direction for expeditious disposal of Maintenance Case No. 942/2022 pending before the Family Court, Raipur. He submits that despite grant of interim maintenance, the matter has remained pending at the stage of respondent's evidence since 14.12.2023 due to repeated adjournments, causing undue hardship to the petitioner. He, therefore, prays that a direction be issued to the Family Court to conclude the proceedings within a reasonable period of time.
3. In view of the aforesaid submission and taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, it is expected that the learned Family Court, Raipur shall make an earnest endeavour to expedite the trial and conclude the proceedings at the earliest possible without granting unnecessary adjournments.
4. With the above observations, the writ petition stands disposed of.
