22/01/2026	Mr. Akath Kumar Yadav, Advocate for petitioner. Ms. Diksha Gouraha, Dy. Govt. Advocate for Resp.-State.
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	Heard. Issue notice to Respondents. Learned State counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondents. She prays for and is granted three weeks' time to file reply. Also heard on I.A. No. 01/2025, application for grant of interim relief/stay. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that petitioner is working as Assistant Grade-II and posted in the office of Collector, Balrampur-Ramanujganj is transferred to the office of Collector, Mungeli, District Mungeli on administrative ground. He contended that petitioner is a district cadre employee and his seniority etc. is maintained district wise. Petitioner has been transferred from out of the district and therefore it will also affect seniority. Therefore, effect and operation of the impugned order shall be kept in abeyance till respondents file reply. He also submits that in writ petitions filed by similarly situated employees, coordinated Bench of this court has granted interim relief in their favour considering same facts. He also submits that petitioner has not been relieved till date. Learned State counsel does not dispute the submission of learned counsel for petitioner with regard to order passed in WPS No. 13827/2025. She however submits that she will file reply to
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the application for grant of interim relief as well.

On due consideration of the submission of learned counsel for the parties, purely as an interim measure, it is directed that transfer of petitioner pursuant to the order Annexure P-2 dated 30.06.2025 shall remained stayed till the next date of hearing.
