ORDER

(PASSED ON 09.05.2026)

1. Parties have filed a compromise petition.
2. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner against the transfer order dated 08-01-2025 whereby the petitioner has been transferred from Artificial Insemination Sub Center Birkona, Block Bilha, District Bilaspur, (C.G.) to Artificial Insemination Sub-Center Mandal Para, District Koriya. During pendency of the present writ petition the respondents/State agreed to kept in abeyance the transfer order of the petitioner dated 08-01-2025 and he would be permitted to remain here at Artificial Insemination Sub Center Birkona, Block Bilha, District Bilaspur, however, he may be transferred again as and when occasion arises.
3. The State has also given their undertaking that they will recall/cancel the said order dated 08-01-2025 with respect to the transfer of the petitioner. The State has also submitted a memo dated 05-05-2026 by which the permission to give undertaking for disposal of the present writ petition and in accordance with the said memo dated 05-05-2026, they gave their consent that they will recall/cancel the transfer order dated 08-01-2025 with respect to the petitioner.
4. The petitioner in person also give his consent that he is ready to withdraw the present petition on the assurance given by the State and he does not press the present writ petition at present.
5. In view of the undertaking given by the State and also the submission made by the petitioner, the present writ petition is **disposed of** under the terms of the undertaking given by the State. However, the petitioner is at liberty to revive his prayer if cause of action so arises.
