10.1 This Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to allow the petition filed by the petitioner;

10.2. This Hon'ble Court be pleased to quash the impugned order dated 04.04.2025, issued by CMO, Municipal Council of Mungeli, Mungeli or direct the R-5 to establish or erect the idol in some other suitable place so as not to disturb traffic of the road and block the entries and exit of the petitioner's shop;
