Learned State Counsel is directed to inform the complainant/father of the victim (PW-2) regarding pendency of the appeal as well as an application for suspension of sentence and grant of bail to the appellant revealing that she can appear on the date fixed and object the prayer in bail application through her counsel. The State may file its reply/objection to I.A. No. 01 of 2024, application for suspension of sentence and grant of bail within a period of two weeks.
