IA No. 2 of 2026 is an application for condonation of delay of 8 days in preferring the appeal. Since the learned State counsel has no objection if delay in filing the appeal is condoned as the accused has statutory right to file an appeal and cause shown by the appellant in filing the appeal beyond the time appears to be satisfactory, we allow the application and condone the delay in filing the present appeal. Learned State Counsel is directed to inform the complainant/mother of the victim (PW-2) regarding pendency of the appeal as well as an application for suspension of sentence and grant of bail to the appellant revealing that she can appear on the date fixed and object the prayer in bail application through her counsel.

The State may file its reply/objection to I.A. No. 01 of 2026, application for suspension of sentence and grant of bail within a period of two weeks.

List the matter after eight weeks for consideration on I.A. No.1 of 2026, application for suspension of sentence and grant of bail.
