Learned State counsel submits that they have submitted reply to answer the submission of learned counsel for petitioner



that the work manual is not applicable and if today case is that petitioner has not passed any order or not having any role in the decision making process of the change of material without sanction from the authority, he may be granted a day's time to seek instruction in the matter and make further submission and prays for listing of this case on Monday.
