10-02-2023	Mr. C.R. Sahu, Advocate for the applicant. Heard. Heard on the application for condonation of delay in filing of instant criminal revision. After due consideration, I.A.No.1 is allowed and the delay of 12 days in filing the criminal revision is condoned. Heard on I.A.No.2, application for grant of interim relief/stay. Learned counsel for the applicant would submit that the learned Family Court has held that according to the Income Tax Return the monthly income of the present applicant is Rs.16,703.33/- and in affidavit he has pleaded his income Rs.10,000/- per month which cannot be accepted as his true income and therefore, granted interim maintenance of Rs.15,000/- per month to the non-applicant/wife which is at higher side. Considering the fact that the applicant has stated his monthly income Rs.10,000/- and according to the Income Tax Return his monthly income is Rs.16,703.33/-, interim maintenance granted by learned Family Court appears to be at higher side, therefore, same is reduced to Rs.10,000/- per month till the next date of hearing. Issue notice to the non-applicant/respondent on payment of P.F. by ordinary as well as registered mode. List this case immediately after service of notice. Sd/- (Rakesh Mohan Pandey) Judge
