06/02/2026	Mr. Shobhit Koshta, counsel for petitioner. Ms. Diksha Gouraha, Dy. G.A. for State-respondents No.1 & 2. Heard. Learned State counsel submits that grievance raised by petitioner on the last date of hearing that petitioner will not be permitted to participate in further proceedings is not correct. According to her instructions, the documents which is enclosed in the writ petition only mentions that petitioner will not be entitled for additional 15 marks because the diploma certificate which petitioner has obtained is subsequent to the last date of submission of form. At this stage, learned counsel for petitioner submits that petitioner is also entitled for additional 15 marks for his additional qualification. Learned State counsel submits that in view of the
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submission made by learned counsel for petitioner, she may be granted two weeks time to file reply.

In view of the submission made by learned counsel for the parties, issue notice to respondents.

Learned State counsel accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 & 2, hence, process fee is not required to be paid for issuance of notice. She prays for and is granted three weeks time to file reply.

Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he has served advance copy to Avinash Singh, Advocate on behalf of respondents No.3 and 4.

In view of the above submission made by learned counsel for petitioner, process fee is not required to be paid for respondents No.3 and 4 also.

List this case in the month of March, 2026.

Interim relief granted earlier to continue till the next date of hearing.
