2. Mr. Jitendra Nath Nande, learned counsel, appears for the respondents.
3. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner with the following prayers:

*"I. The Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to issue a writ of ceritorari quashing/setting aside the impugned award partly dated 20.12.2024 (Annex.P/25) only regarding cancellation of E-Tender (work order and agreement which is passed by learned sole arbitrator.*

*II. The Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to issue a writ of ceritorari quashing/setting aside the impugned award partly dated 20.12.2024 (Annex. P/25) only regarding made the payment upto 30.08.2021 passed by learned sole arbitrator and directed to the*

*respondent authorities to pay the amount regarding plying the vehicle as per work order and agreement upto April 2022, because it is admitted by documentary proof as per Annex.P/18, that the aforesaid 3 vehicles is plying upto April 2022.*

*III. Any other reliefs which this Hon'ble Court deem fit in the circumstances of the case, may also be granted to the petitioner together with the cost of this writ petition."*

4. Today, when the case is called, learned counsel for the petitioner is not present, nor is any representation made on behalf of the petitioner to press this petition despite repeated calls, and it appears that the petitioner has lost interest in pursuing the matter.

5. Accordingly, the present petition is **dismissed for want of prosecution.**
