21/04/2026	Ms. Meena Shastri, Advocate for the appellants. Mr. Anand Gupta, Dy. Govt. Advocate for respondent No.2/ State. Heard on the question of admission. The Appeal is admitted for hearing on the following substantial question of law : 1. Whether the finding of First Appellate Court in reversing the judgment and decree of the learned Trial Court, on the issue of limitation is contrary to law and evidence available on record? 2. Whether the learned First Appellate Court was justified in reversing the well-

reasoned findings of the learned trial Court holding that the plaintiff has proved his claim on the basis of sale deed dated 02/05/1997 (Ex. P-1)?

Issue notice to the respondents.

Mr. Anand Gupta, Dy. Govt. Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.2/ State. Hence process fee need not be paid for respondent No.2.

Let notice be issued to respondent No.1 on payment of process fee within ten days.

Also heard on I.A. No.1/2026, an application for grant of interim relief/ Stay.

Learned counsel for the appellants submits that the execution proceedings have been initiated pursuant to the impugned judgment and decree dated 15.11.2025 and the appellants are in possession of the property in question, therefore, he prays for stay of the execution of the impugned judgment and decree in respect of the said property.

Having considered the entire facts and circumstances of the case and for the reasons mentioned in the application, it is directed that the effect and operation of the judgment and decree dated 15/11/2025 passed by the learned 1st District Judge, Manendragarh, District Koriya (C.G.) in Civil Appeal No.25-A/2025 in respect of the suit property, shall remain stayed, till the next date of hearing.

Accordingly, I.A. No.1 is hereby disposed of.
