1. The applicant has filed this instant revision petition with the following prayer:

“ It is therefore, prayed that this Hon'ble High Court may kindly be pleased -

(I) to call for records of Complaint Case No. 810/2019 (Roshan Verma Vs Shri Rajesh Jain & others) from the Court of learned JMFC Bemetara.

(II) to allow the petition thereby setting aside the impugned order dated 22.10.2024 & 20.12.2024 (Annexure A/1) passed by the learned Judicial Magistrate First Class (Presiding Officer Shri M. Jahangeer Tigala), Bemetara (C.G.) in Complaint Case No. 810/2019 Roshan Verma Vs

Rajesh Jain & others as also the entire proceedings as well as sanction order dated 23.05.2019 (Annexure A/4), in the interest of justice.

(III) To declare that issuance of process is unsustainable before taking cognizance of offence.

(IV) to grant any other relief deemed fit and proper in the facts and circumstances of the case. ”

2. The learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw this instant petition, with liberty to the petitioners to approach to the trial Court.
3. Learned State counsel has no objection.
4. Permission is granted.
5. In view of the above, the instant petition is **dismissed as withdrawn** with liberty to the petitioners to approach to the trial Court.
6. Let a certified copy of this order as well as the original records, be transmitted to the concerned trial Court for necessary compliance and follow up action, if any.
