pond and not to disturb the villagers. The said letter goes to suggest that the allotment of the land in question is being disputed by the villagers stating that it is *nistari land*.

Considering the aforesaid aspect of the matter, it is directed that any construction or any allotment would be subject to final outcome of this petition and the Respondent No.6 is at liberty to raise construction on its own risks and costs.
