Mr. Pravesh Sahu, counsel for respondent No.3. Heard on I.A. No.1, an application for condonation of delay in filing the appeal. Ms. Jangde, the learned counsel appearing for the appellants would submit that it is an appeal filed by the claimants and there is delay of 53 days. She would further submit that due to poverty and ignorance, the appellants could not prefer appeal within limitation. She would contend that the appellants have explained the delay part properly. She would pray to condone the delay. On the other hand, learned counsels appearing for the
